Sanitary Protocol

For the activities taking place at the René-Lévêque Sports Center (DDM) in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic

BEFORE YOU REGISTER

Before registering, please read this document carefully, all registrations must be accompanied by the order form.

The deadline for registrations will be September 9, 2020. It will be very important to submit by this date, we reserve the right to cancel the event if we do not have enough registrations by this date. Last minute registrations, we will only accept you if there is room left in the competition session that you are dancing.

We are all aware of the current situation and if Public Health Department says all events should be canceled, we will cancel the competition, and we will REFUND all participants and spectators.

We are restricted to 140 people (per session) in the room, including around 26 people who will be on site all day (judges and volunteers).

The 2020 DDM edition will be a lot different from what we have seen in the past and we hope that the original formula will be back next year. The event will take place in session throughout the day. For example: a children's session in the morning, adults basic and pro-am in the afternoon and Amateur open in the evening. See the provisional timetable for details.

We estimate a number of dancers at 50-60 per block, plus judges and volunteers still on site, so there should be an estimated 80 places left for spectators.

Unfortunately, due to the current situation, we cannot give out medals or flowers to the winners. On the other hand, we will have a big podium (2 meters between positions) for pictures.

SANITARY MEASURES

Wearing a face cover is mandatory at all times to circulate in the room and to the washrooms. You will be able to remove your mask ONLY when dancing or sitting. Hand disinfection will be available upon on entry. The entrance will be from the school parking lot and the EXIT on the other side, rue Dupras.

PRO-AM

You are free to dance with or without the mask. It is a personal choice between the professional and the student, we refer you to the government site for the procedures.

NO SALE OF FOOD AND ALCOHOL

SPECTATORS

NO tickets will be sold at the door, tickets must be ordered and paid (e-transfer) for in advance via the ORDER FORM which must be completed. We will keep a log of everyone who will be in the room at each session. Tickets sold separately for each session.

In the room, there will be no tables, only chairs. People living at the same address (or dancing together) will be able to sit together, others will be separated every 2 meters. As we are in a period of uncertainty, we cannot invest in a lighting budget as usual, given the limited number of people allowed in the room, it was obvious that we would have to cut expenses.

CLOAKROOMS

We will have the usual 2 changing rooms at the entrance. Inside the locker rooms we will demarcate spaces (2 meters), we will have volunteers in each of the locker rooms and there will be no more than 2 or 3 people in the locker room at a time. We advise you to bring your personal belongings inside the competition hall to avoid returning there several times.
